




# Texas Instruments TI-84 Plus Color Silver Edition Teardown

### TOOLS:


- P6 Pentalobe Screwdriver 2009 MacBook Pro Battery (1)
- Philips 0 Screw Driver (1)

## Step 1 — Take out the battery




- I do not have the battery for mine but to replace it just unplug the cable and buy a new one made for this device

## Step 2 — Remove the back cover/ front button shield



- Remove the back cover by removing the 6 Pentalobe screws (P6)
- the front cover can be taken off by prying it off from the front of the device
- then pry off the back cover it can be little challenging but take your time

## Step 3 — disassemble the mother board



- Remove the 6 Philips screws holding the mother board and if you want remove the foil just to see the full board itself
- To change out the buttons take out the grey rubber sheet that separates them from the board (be careful with the buttons as they will fall out)
