




# ThinkPad X1 Carbon (2nd Gen) Battery Disconnection




- [Phillips #00 Screwdriver](#) (1)

## Step 1 — Cover



- Remove the 7 philips head screws from the back.
- Lift off back cover.

## Step 2 — Battery Disconnection



- Using a plastic pry tool disconnect the battery from the motherboard.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
