




# ThinkPad X1 Carbon Wireless Card Replacement

## INTRODUCTION

In this guide, you will learn how to open the ThinkPad X1 Carbon and replace the wireless card.

### TOOLS:

- **Phillips #0 Screwdriver** (1)
- **Spudger** (1)

## Step 1 — Loosen Cover Screws



- Using the #0 Phillips screwdriver, loosen the seven cover screws. they will not come all of the way out.

## Step 2



- Using the spudger pop the cover loose and remove.

## Step 3 — Disconnect Battery



**⚠** Use only plastic tools to disconnect battery cable


- Slide battery connector in the direction of the arrow to disconnect.
- **i** You can leave the battery or remove it using the red circles for the screw locations.

## Step 4



- Remove screw holding the wireless card in place.

## Step 5 — Remove Antenna Cables



- Carefully remove the antenna cables and slide out the card in the direction of the arrow.
- i* The gray connector is on the top. The black connector is closer to the battery.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
