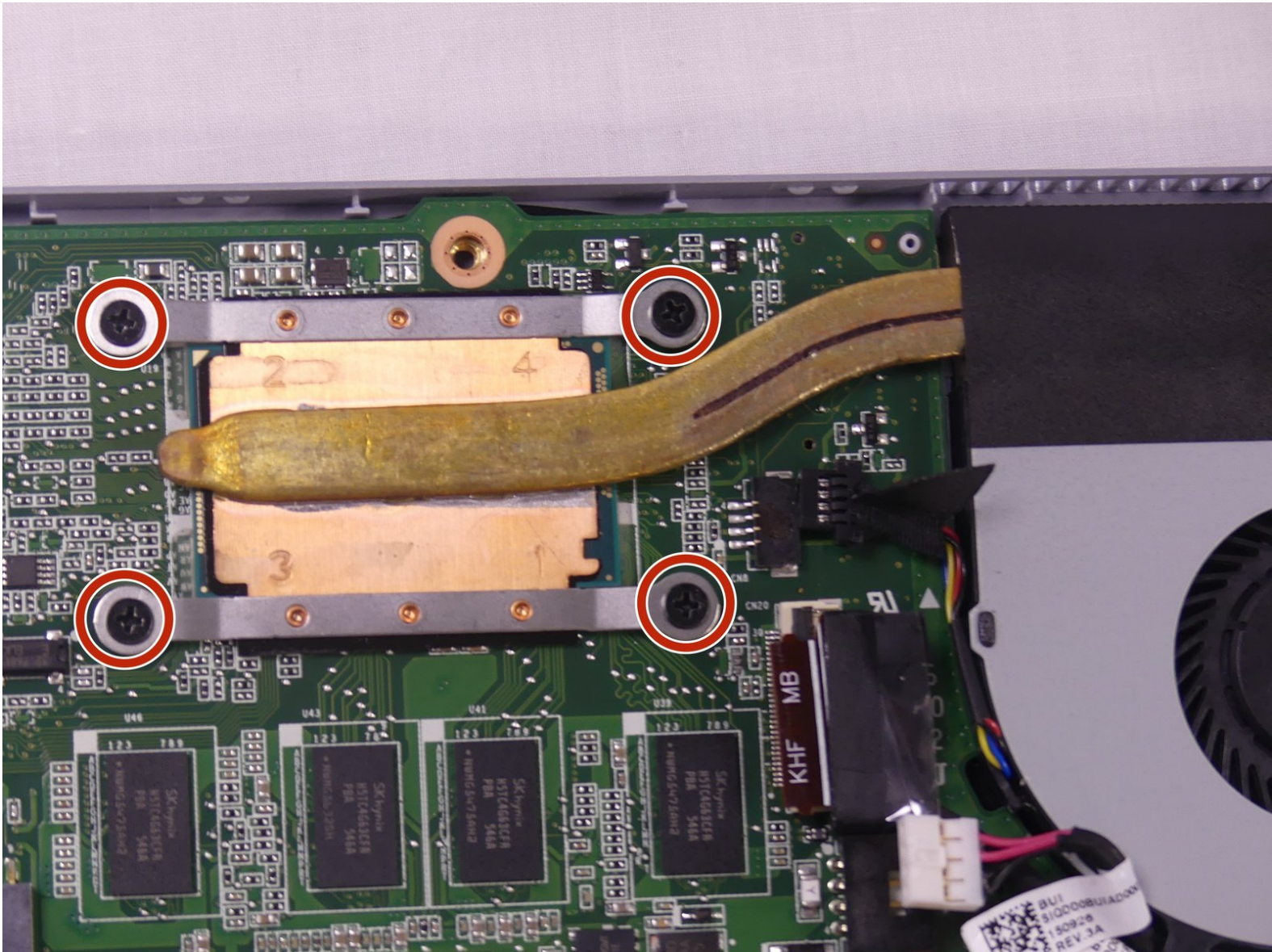




# Toshiba CB35-3350 Chromebook 2 Fan Replacement

## INTRODUCTION

To complete this guide you will need to work with a steady, gentle hand. Just so you do not mess it up.

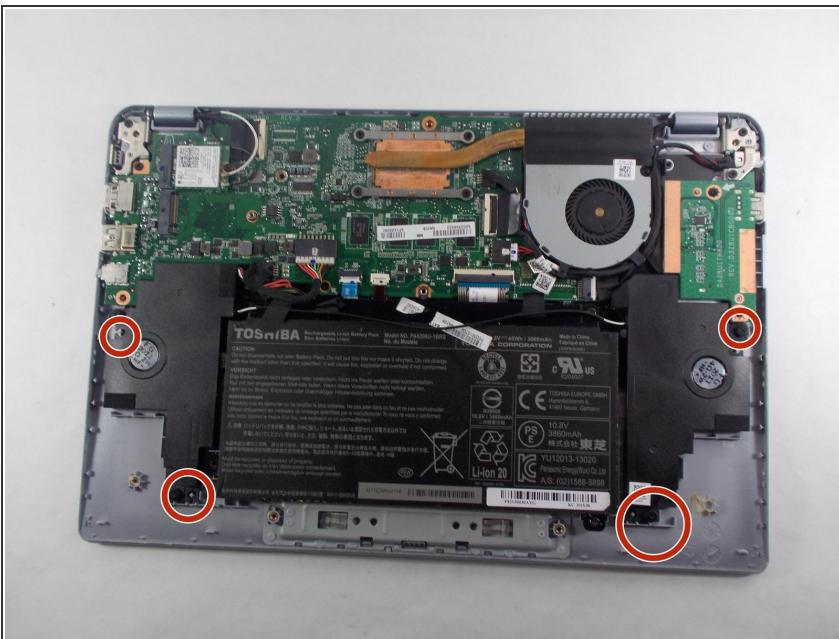
- [Phillips #0 Screwdriver](#) (1)

## Step 1 — Battery



- Remove the Phillips #0 screws from the back of the laptop.
- Use your hands and an iFixit opening tool to remove the back of the laptop.

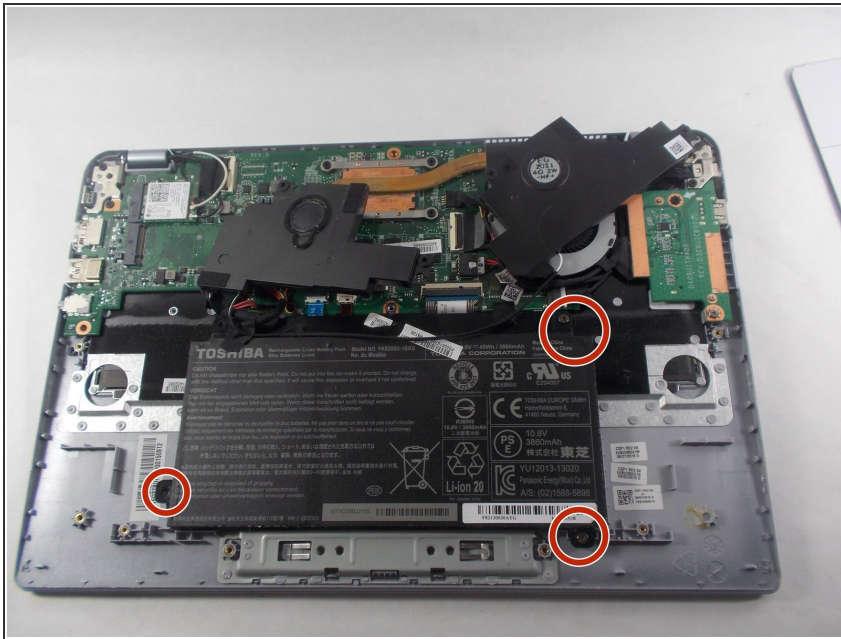
## Step 2



- Remove the four Phillips #0 screws from the speakers.
- Move the speakers out of the way.

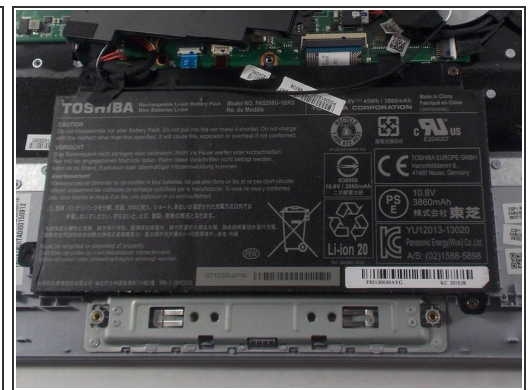


## Step 3



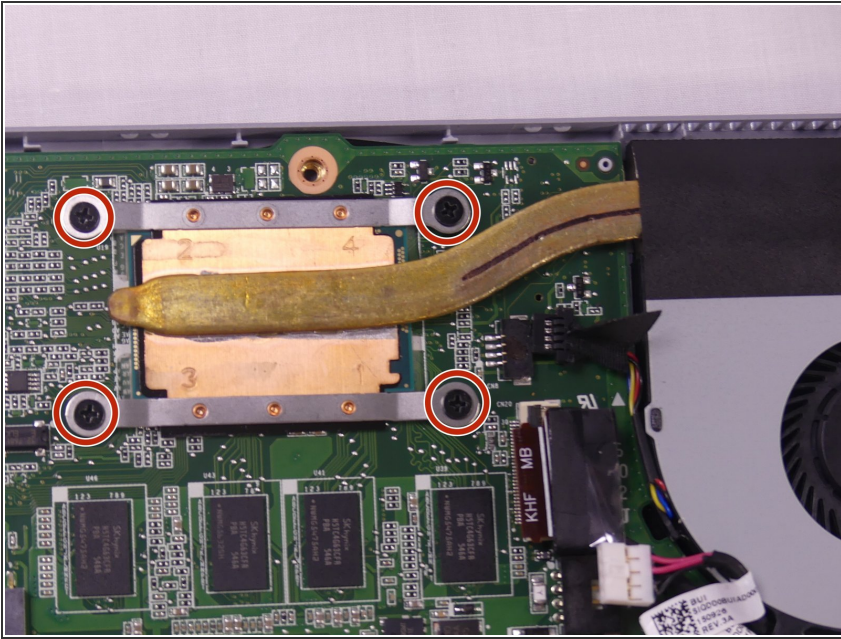
- Remove the three Phillips #0 screws from the battery.

## Step 4



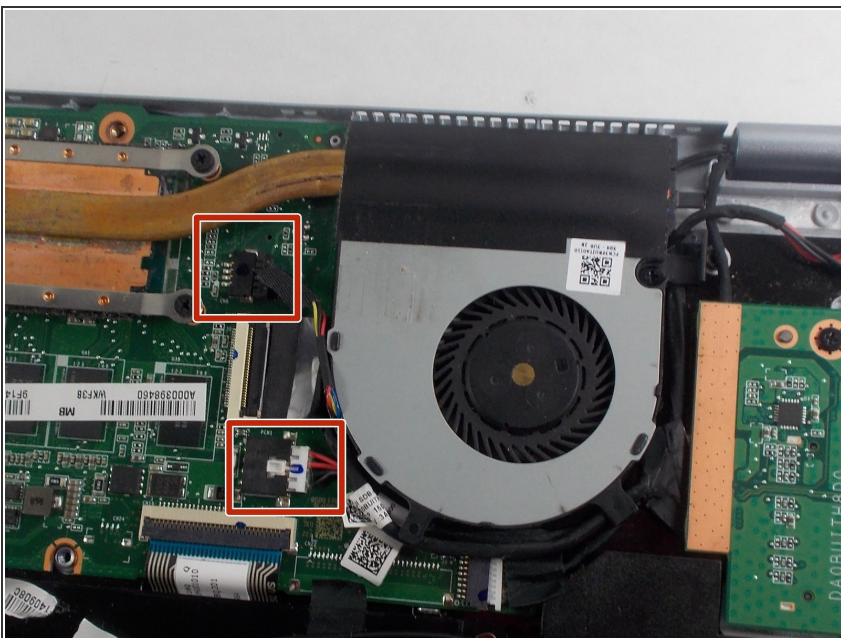
- Unplug the wires connecting the battery to the motherboard.
- Remove the battery from the laptop.

## Step 5 — Fan



- Unscrew the four captive Phillips #0 screws from the heat sink.

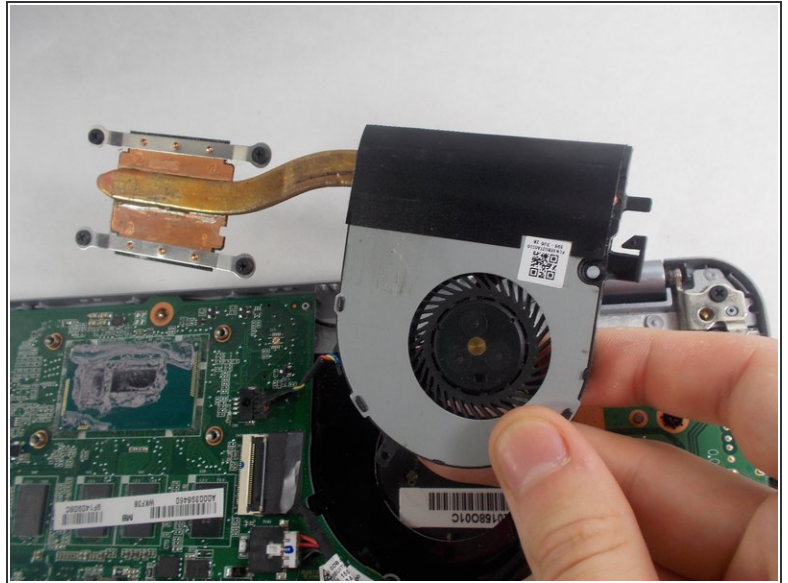
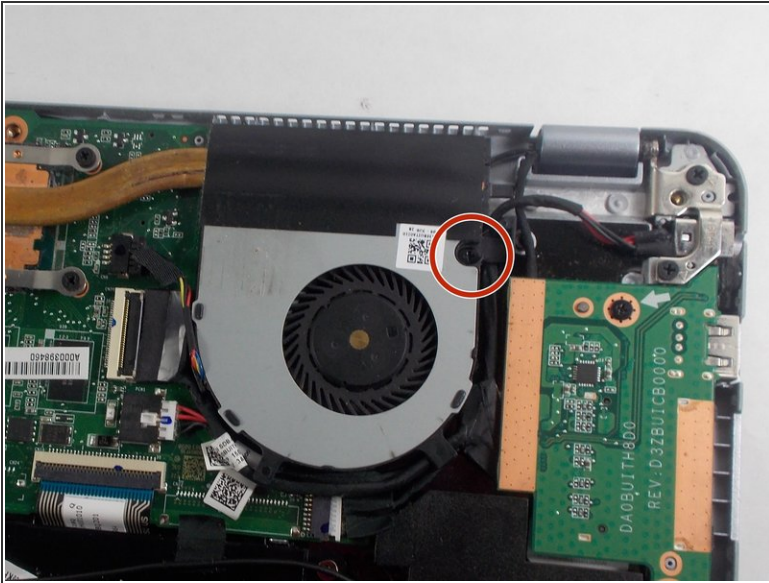
## Step 6



- Detach the wires connecting the fan to the motherboard.



## Step 7



- Detach the wire from the fan.
- Remove the fan from the laptop.
