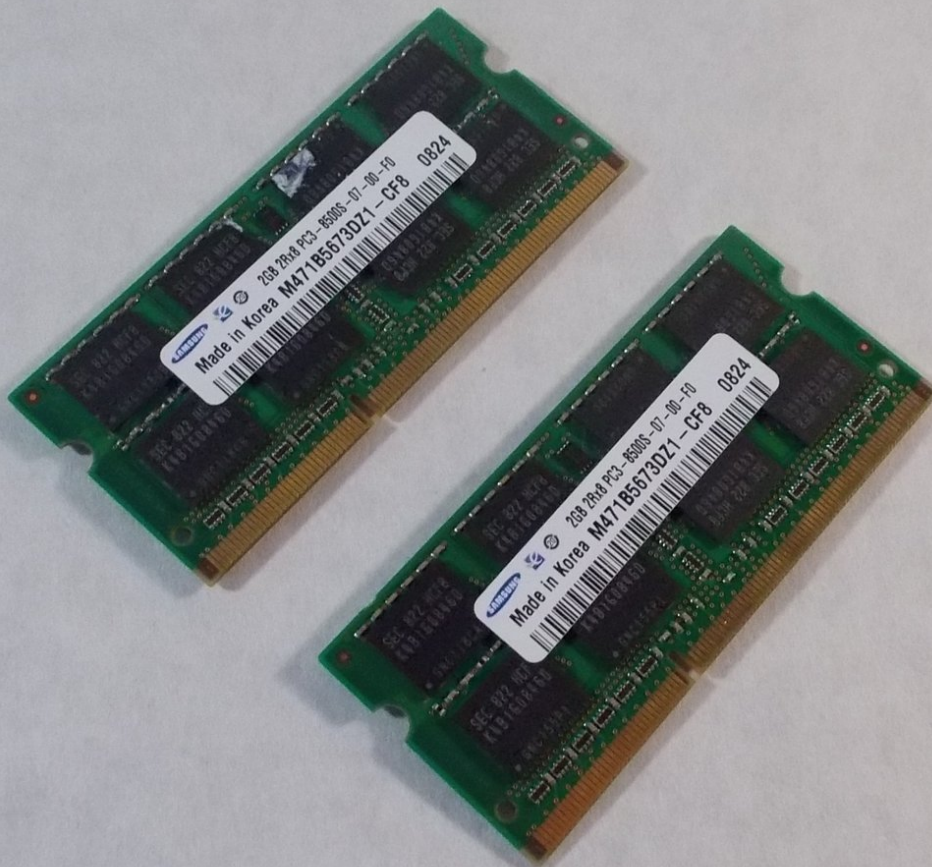




Toshiba Qosmio X305-Q704 RAM Replacement

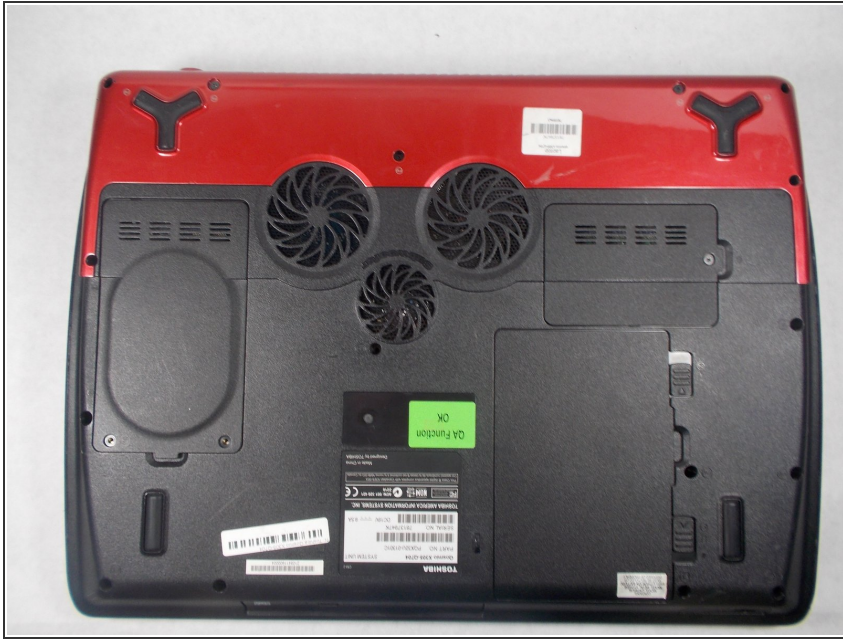
INTRODUCTION

If your computer is running slow or becomes cold this can be due to a faulty RAM or you not having enough RAM in the computer. Use this guide to remove and replace your RAM.

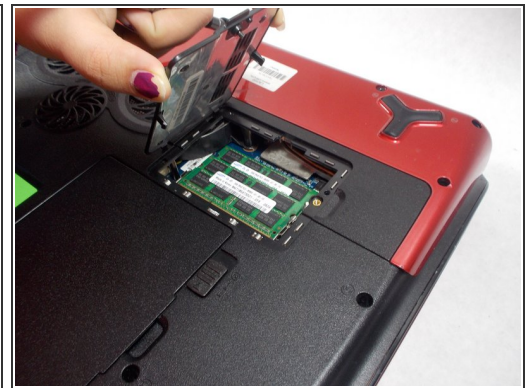
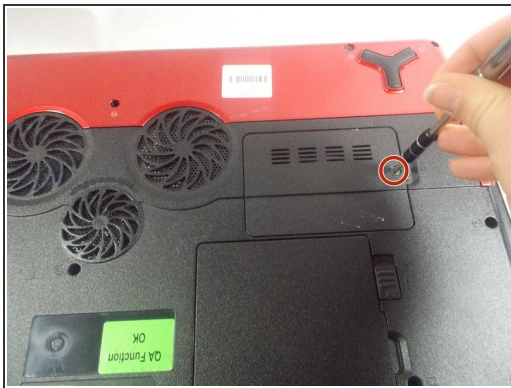

Step 1 — RAM



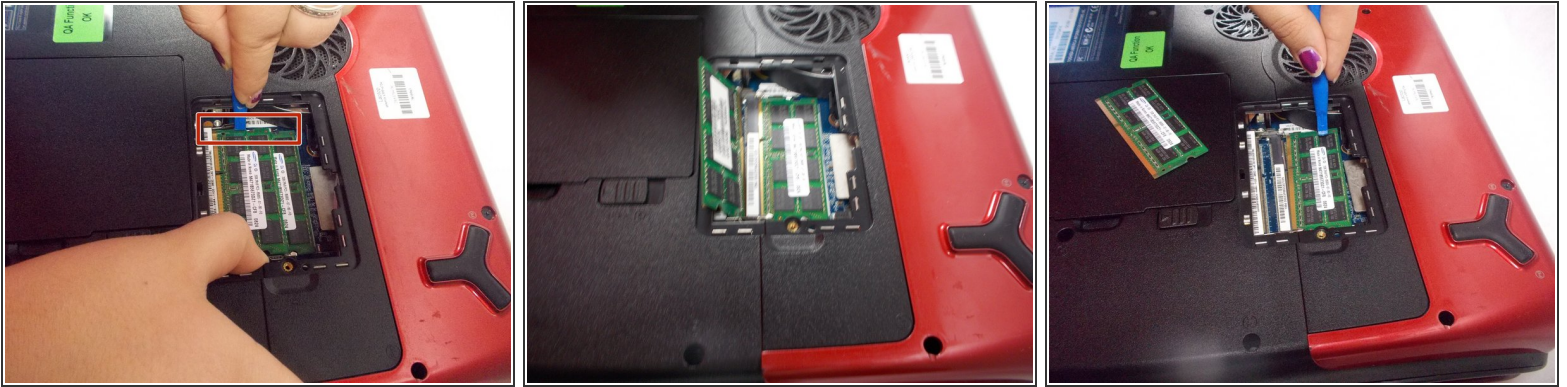
- Flip your device over so that you're facing the back cover of your device.

Step 2




- Use a Phillips #0 screwdriver to unscrew the single 8 mm screw and remove the RAM cover.

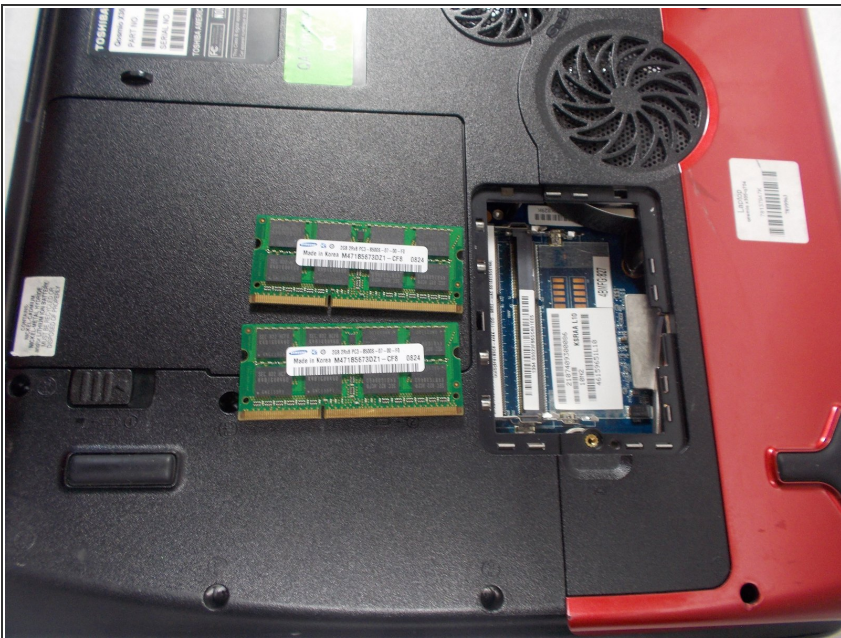
Step 3



- Using the iFixit opening tools, press on the two metal pieces holding the RAM cartridge in place. Do this for both RAM cards.

 The card will pop up at an angle so you can remove it by hand.

Step 4



- Remove the RAM sticks from your device.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
