INTRODUCTION

Remove the RAM module with this guide. Reverse the steps to install a new one to allow for more laptop storage.



TOOLS:

- [Phillips #00 Screwdriver](#) (1)

Step 1 — Battery



- Close the laptop, and flip it upside down. You want the spine to be furthest away from you.

Step 2



- Release the locking mechanism by switching the left slider to the left.

Step 3



- Slide the right slider to the right, and simultaneously, pull the battery out at a diagonal angle.

Step 4 — RAM



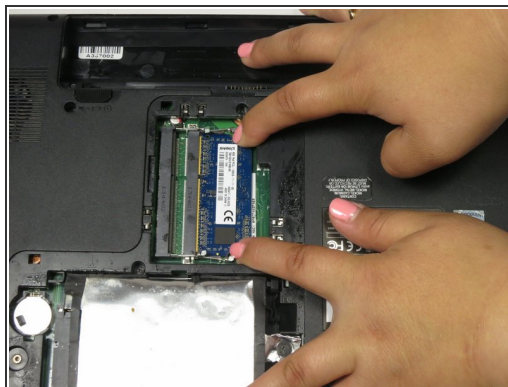
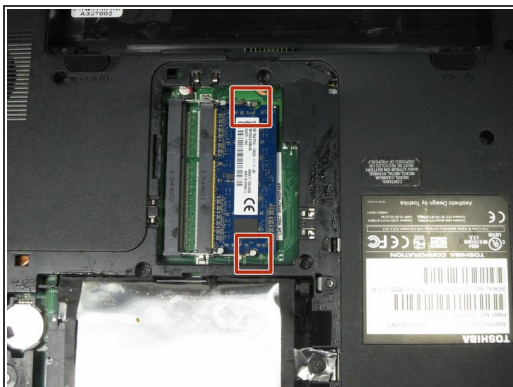
- With the Phillips #0 screwdriver, unscrew the 4.6mm screw on the left side of the "L"-shaped covering.

Step 5



- Lift up the "L"-shaped plastic covering to remove it.

Step 6



- Push the two metal prongs on either side of the RAM module away from the module simultaneously.
- Lift up the RAM module to remove.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
