INTRODUCTION

In the case you need to replace the cooling fan and heat sink of your Toshiba Satellite C55D-C5106, this guide will show you the steps on how to perform the task.

TOOLS:

- Metal Spudger (1)
- Phillips #1 Screwdriver (1)

Step 1 — Cooling Fan and Heat Sink




- Turn the laptop off and remove any external power sources.
- Flip the laptop upside down.
- Remove all of the 12 screws that secure the back cover to the laptop with a Phillips #1 screwdriver.

Step 2



- Pull the battery toward yourself until it is completely removed from the laptop. The battery should detach easily.

Step 3




- Run the metal spudger around the seam between the back cover and the rest of the laptop.
- Use the metal spudger to remove the bottom cover of the laptop.

Step 4



- Use the Phillips #1 screwdriver to remove the screw securing the fan.

Step 5



- Loosen the four screws securing the heat sink using the same screwdriver.
- (i)* These screws cannot be removed.

Step 6



- Disconnect the fan from the motherboard by removing the white holder with the red, yellow, and black wires.

Step 7



- Pull the fan and heat sink away from the motherboard.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
