## INTRODUCTION

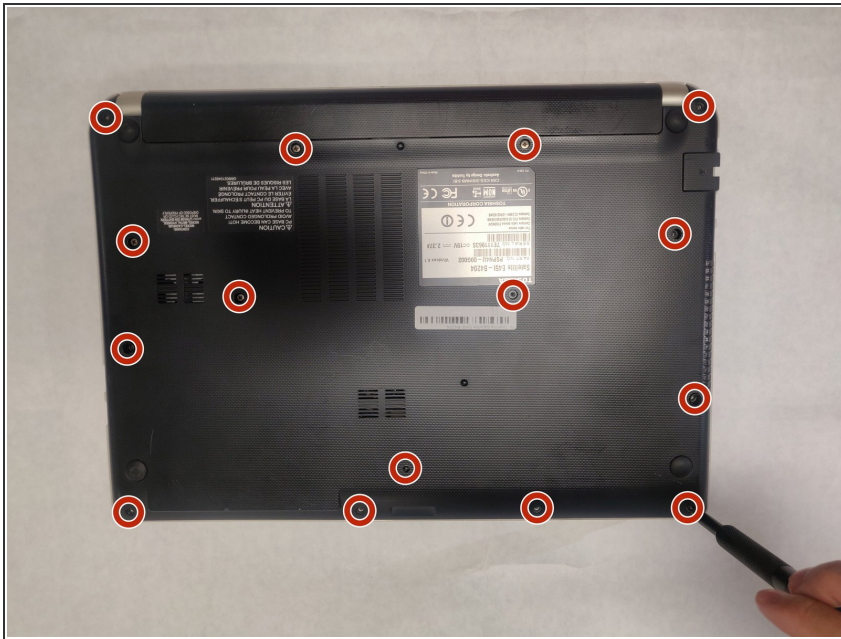

## Step 1 — Trackpad



- Remove 15 screws with the Phillips #1 screwdriver.

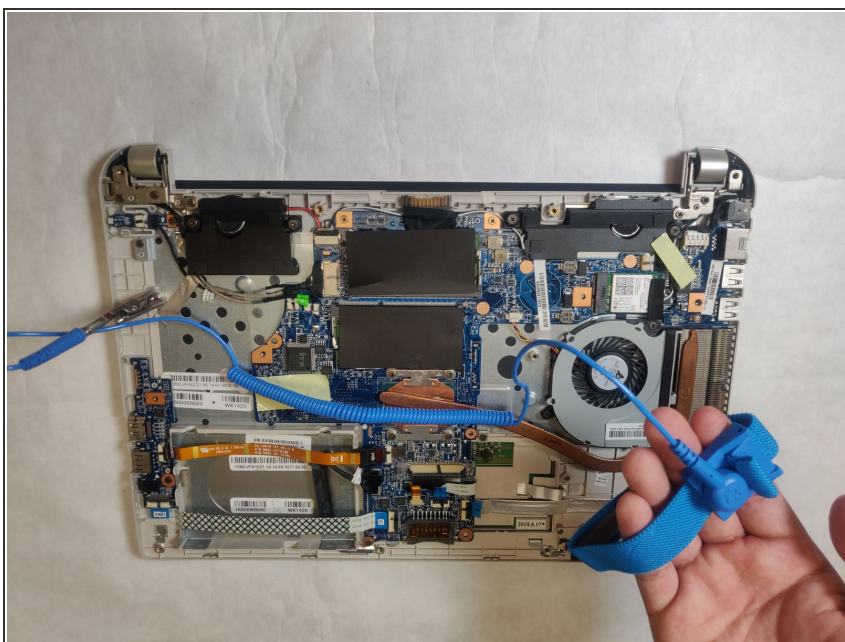

- Remove Battery

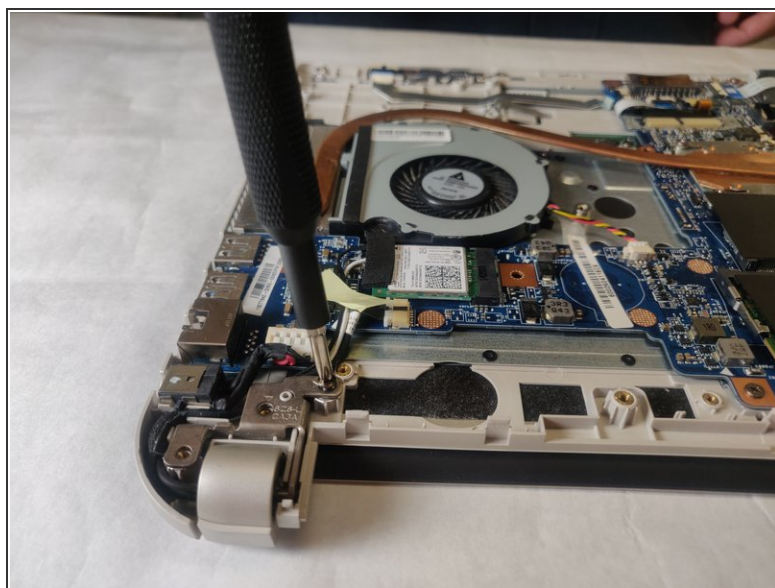
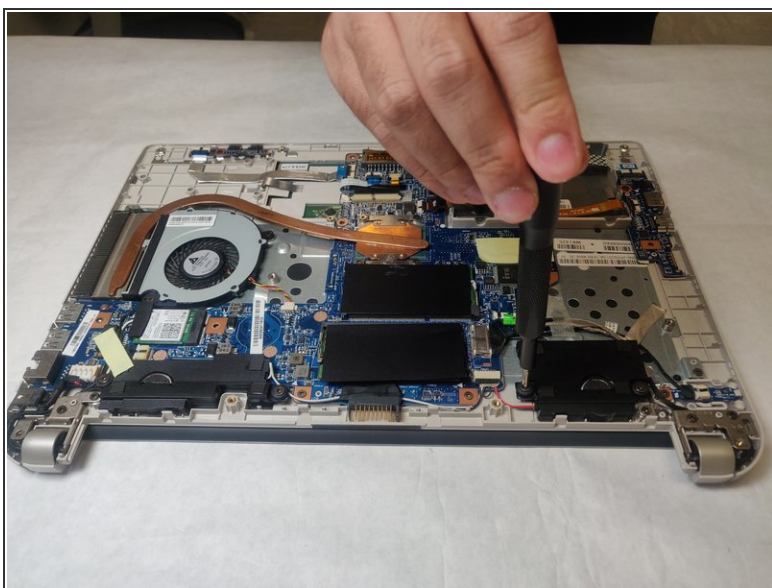


## Step 3



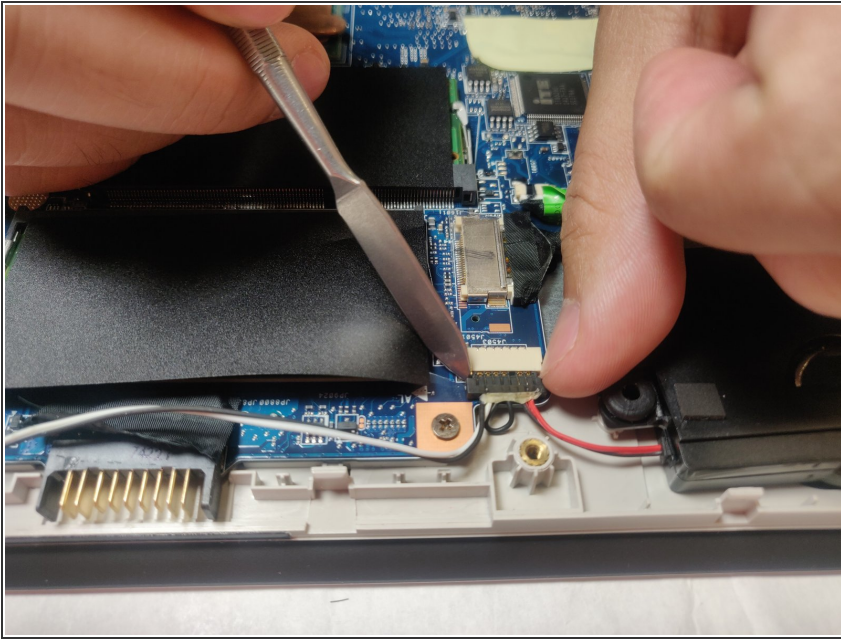
- Ground yourself.

## Step 4



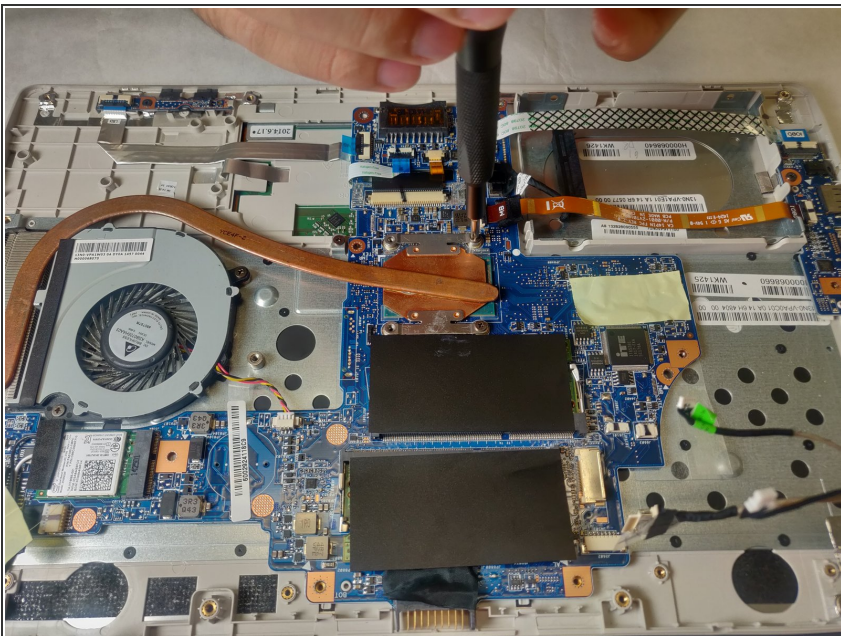
- Remove speaker screws.

- Remove processor.

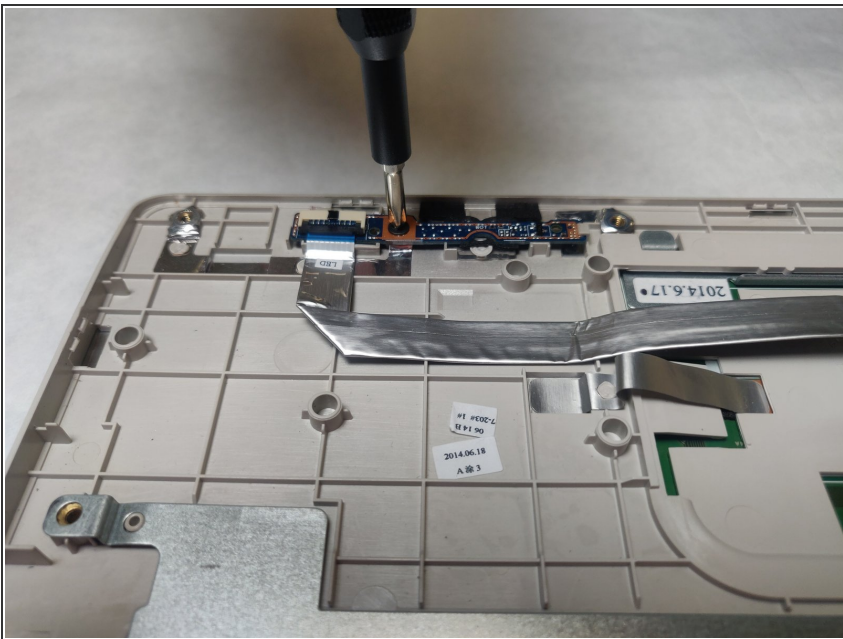


## Step 7



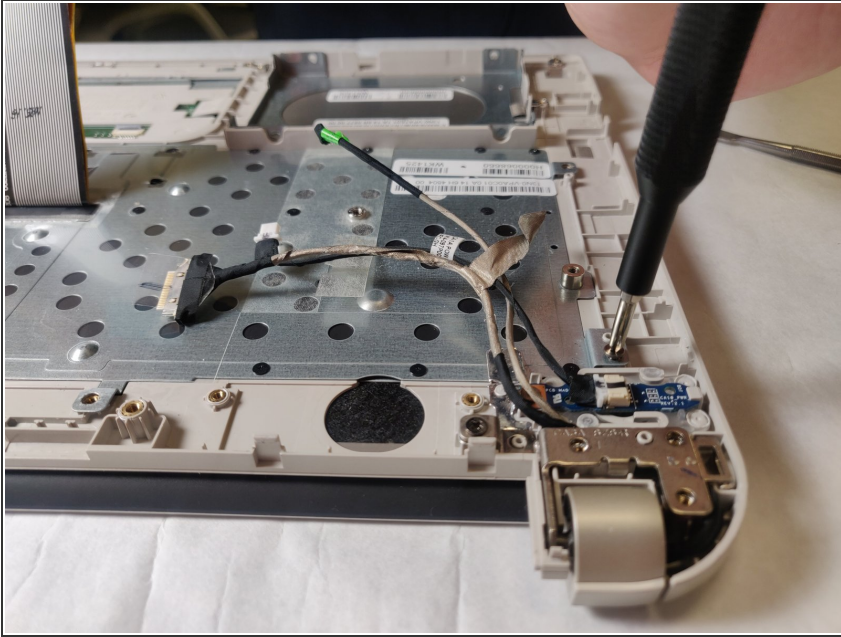
- Remove heatsink.

## Step 8



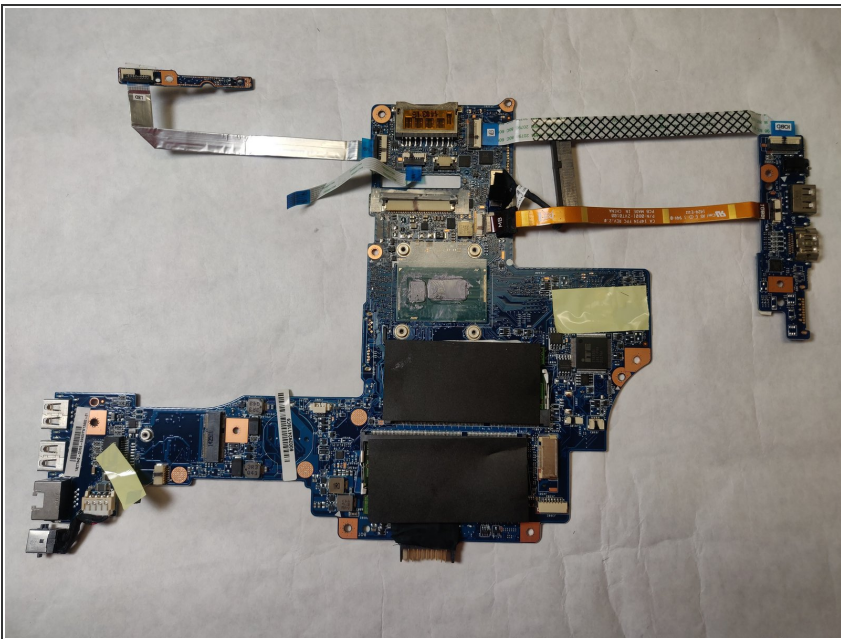
- Remove WiFi chip.

## Step 9



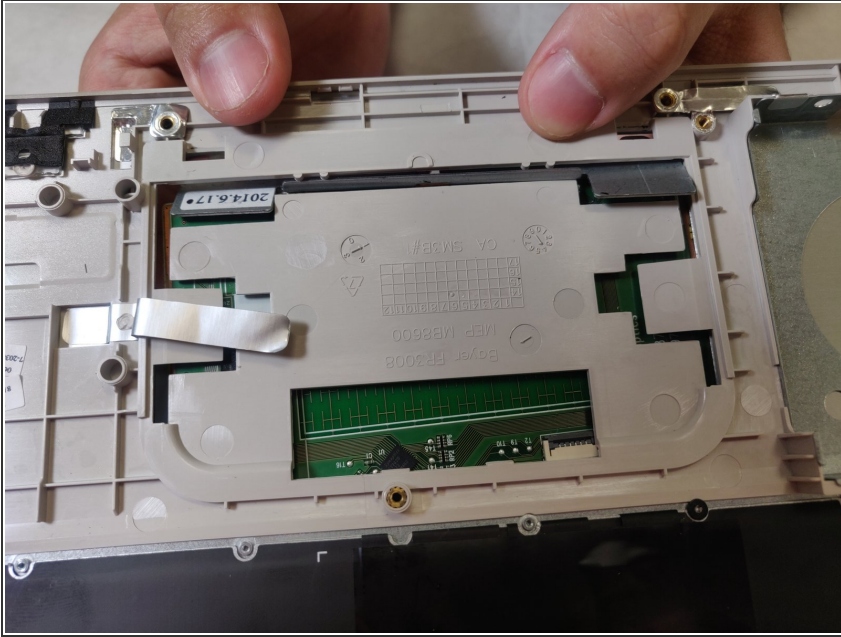
- Remove keyboard screws.
