INTRODUCTION

This guide will help you replace the case that houses the audio jack in case it is broken or cracked.

TOOLS:

- [Phillips #00 Screwdriver](#) (1)

Step 1 — Audio Jack Case




- Locate the audio control board and the three 1.10 mm screws found on the back.

Step 2



- Unscrew the three 1.10 mm screws using a #00 Phillips head screwdriver.


Step 3



- Using a plastic opening tool, insert it between the two plastic pieces to pry it open.

(i) Note: The pieces should look like the second picture when it is opened.

Step 4



⚠ Carefully removed the audio board from casing.

- Replace broken pieces with new ones and reassemble.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
