



# Turtle Beach Ear Force XO Seven Microphone Windscreen Replacement

This guide will illustrate how to remove the windscreen on a microphone.

## INTRODUCTION

The windscreen is designed to prevent dust and moisture from getting into the microphone. It is held onto the microphone by a single 0.4 cm long Phillips head screw attached by a mounting bracket. Due to its fragile design, the windscreen can easily be torn, but it can quickly be replaced with the help of this guide.

## TOOLS:

- Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)

## Step 1 — Unplug microphone from headset




- First remove the microphone from the headset. Pull gently on the end of the microphone where it attaches to the headset.

## Step 2 — Removing the screw



- Using a Philips #0 screwdriver, unscrew the 4-mm-long screw that attaches the windscreen to the microphone.

### Step 3 — Remove metal plate and then windscreens



- Now that the screw is removed, remove the slim metal plate at the base of the windscreens by gently pulling on the plate.
- Then slide the windscreens off of the microphone.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
