INTRODUCTION

What you can expect from this guide is a step by step process on how to remove the plastic case on a Verizon Ellipsis Jetpack MHS800L.

TOOLS:

Step 1 — Plastic Case



- Remove the SIM card, that is located on top of the Jetpack.

Step 2



- With the device on its back and the label facing you, remove the rubber screw cover on the top left corner of the device.
- Under the rubber circle, remove the 1.25 mm screw using a Philips #00 screwdriver.
- *(i)* You may need to peel back a piece of double sided tape covering the screw hole.

Step 3



- Remove three 1.25 mm screws.

Step 4



- Use a plastic opening tool at the seams and pry open the case.

Step 5



- Once the cover is off, this is what your device will look like.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
