INTRODUCTION

This guide provides instructions on how to replace the front-facing camera on a Xelio P900A-BK.

TOOLS:


- [5mm Nut Driver](#) (1)
- [iFixit Opening Tools](#) (1)

Step 1 — Front Facing Camera




- Remove the two 5.4mm bottom screws.
- Set aside.

Step 2




- Insert a plastic opening tool between the screen and the rear case and carefully pry the tablet open.
- Gently work your way around the entire tablet and do not force the case open prematurely.
- *(i)* You will hear the plastic latches pop free.

Step 3




- Remove the connection between the camera and the motherboard.
- Open the black ribbon holder then remove the ribbon from its connection.

Step 4



- Remove the tape covering the front facing camera entirely to expose one of the motherboard screws.

Step 5



- Use the smaller plastic opening tool to remove the camera from its socket.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
