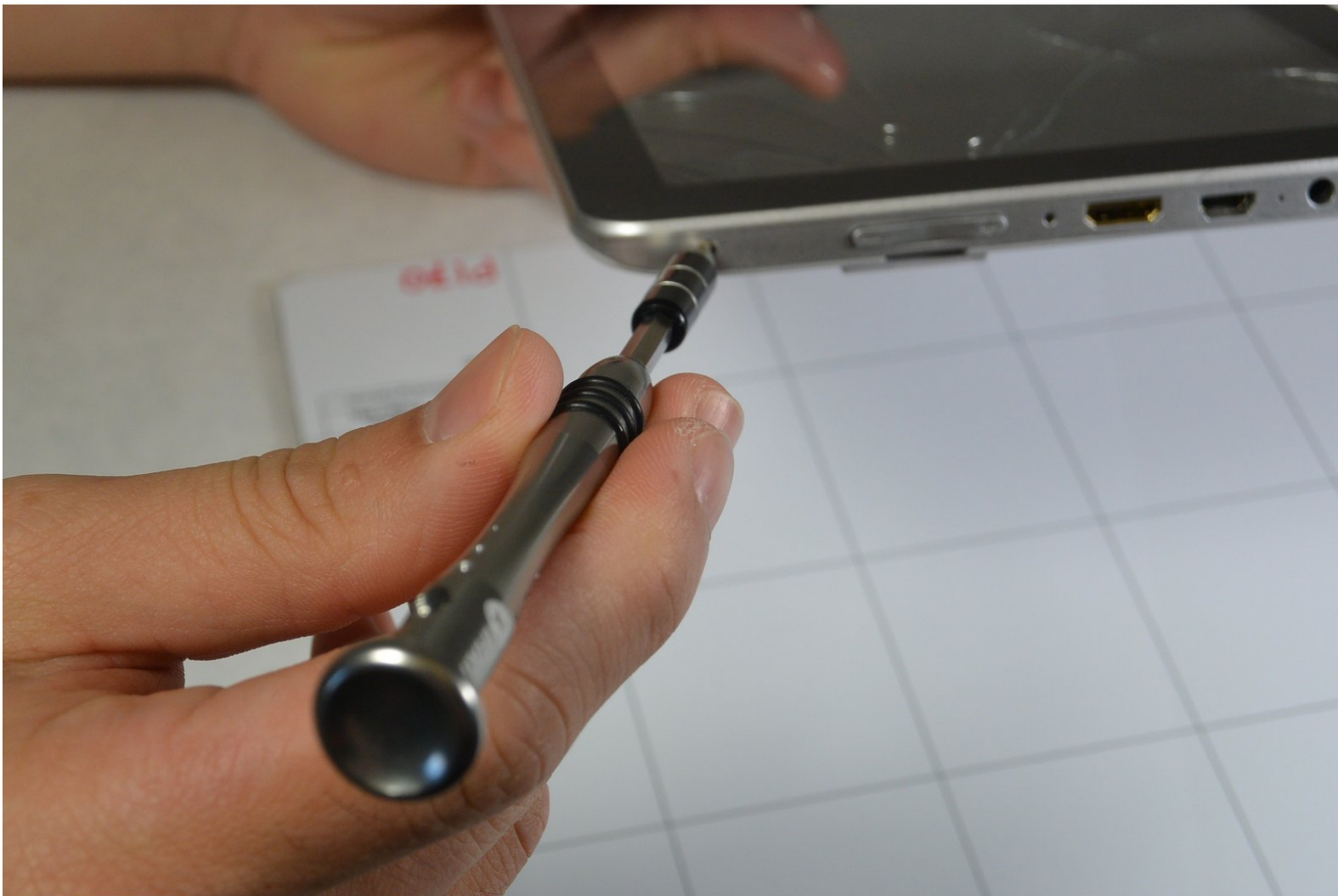




Zeki TBQG884B Rear Case Replacement

Replace the rear case of the Zeki TBQG884B tablet.

INTRODUCTION

Use this guide to replace the rear cover of your Zeki TBQG884B tablet, or as a prerequisite for repairs on any of the device's other internal components.

Step 1 — Rear Case



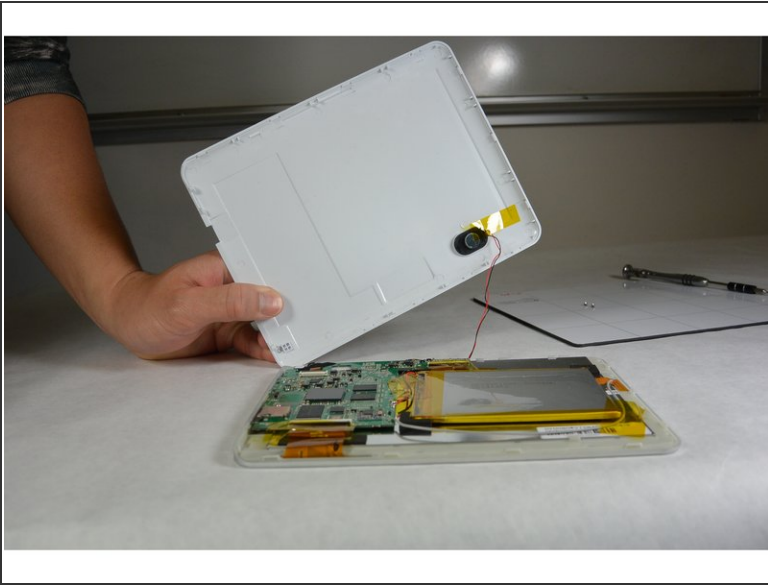
- Remove the two screws from the end of the device where the ports are located.

Step 2



- Rest the tablet on the glass face.
- Insert the tip of a plastic opening tool into the small gap, between the grey and white plastic. Pry it open, (you should hear the clips opening up).
- Gently work your way around the perimeter of the tablet's edge.

Step 3



- Separate the back and face plates.
 - Remove any tape on the speaker, and detach the speaker from the back plate.
- ⚠ The speaker is connected to the motherboard by two soldered wires. Don't break them when you remove the speaker.
