

Step 1 — Introduction



- So, here's the catch: this logic board officially only supports the DDR3 PC3-8500, which runs at 1066MHz, but that's not entirely true. Its 4 slots supports 1333 MHz. You can try other capacities over what was used on my setup, but I cannot guarantee that it will work.

Step 2



- 3 slots running at 1333 MHz each.

Step 3



- This is the configuration layout that you should follow (Livre means "Free"), otherwise it won't work in my setup.

Step 4 — Exact Models Used



- Please note that probably the only memories supported by the Logic Board in higher frequencies are the ones with 4 chips on front and 4 chips on the back.
- 1 x 4 GB
- 2 x 2 GB
