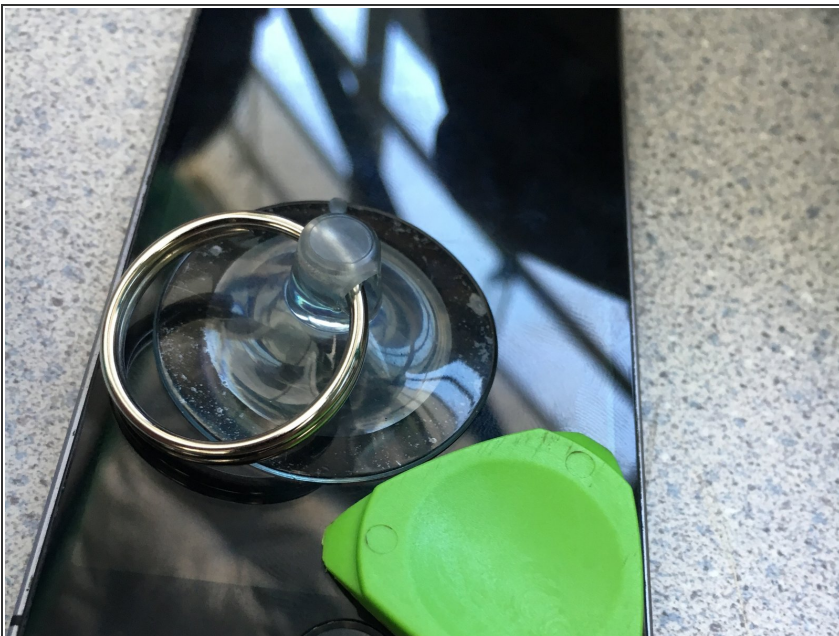

## Step 1 — Unscrewing the screen



- First step is to locate the two screws at the bottom part of the phone . These screws are small be extremely careful

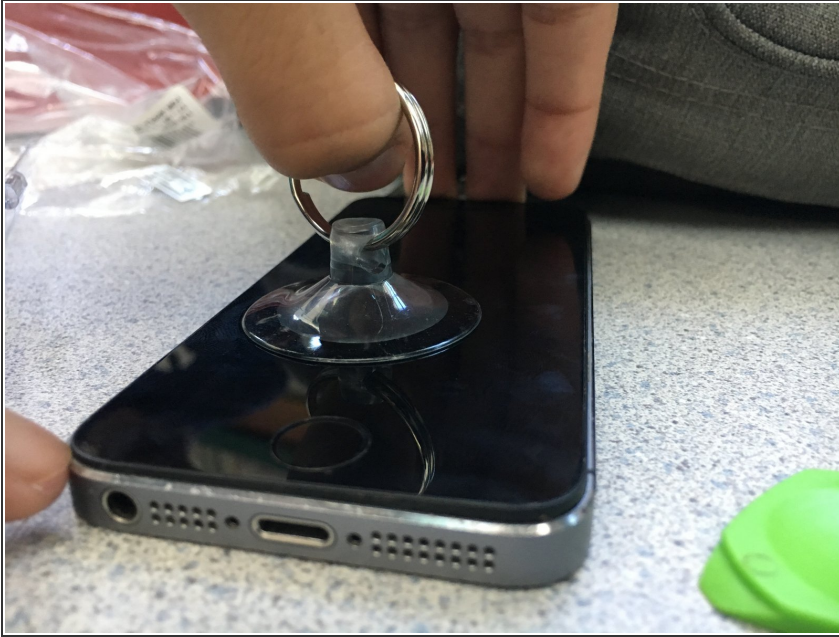
## Step 2



- You are going to need these two tools to take off the screen

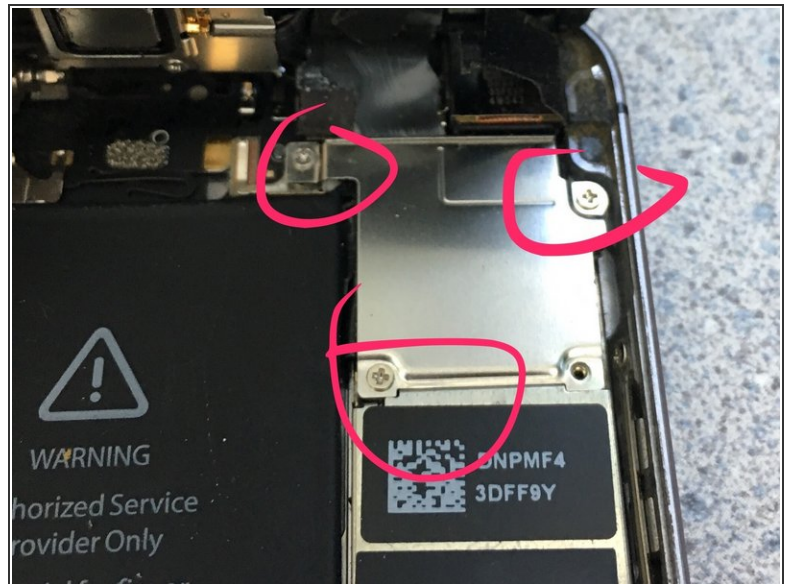


### Step 3 — Lifting the screen off



- Gently Pull the screen up while slowly using the green tool to pry the screen up

### Step 4 — Taking the screen off of the phone



- To completely take the screen off the phone, unscrew the four screws keeping the phone

## Step 5 — Taking off the home Button



- unscrew these two screws (these screws are VERY SMALL be careful)

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
