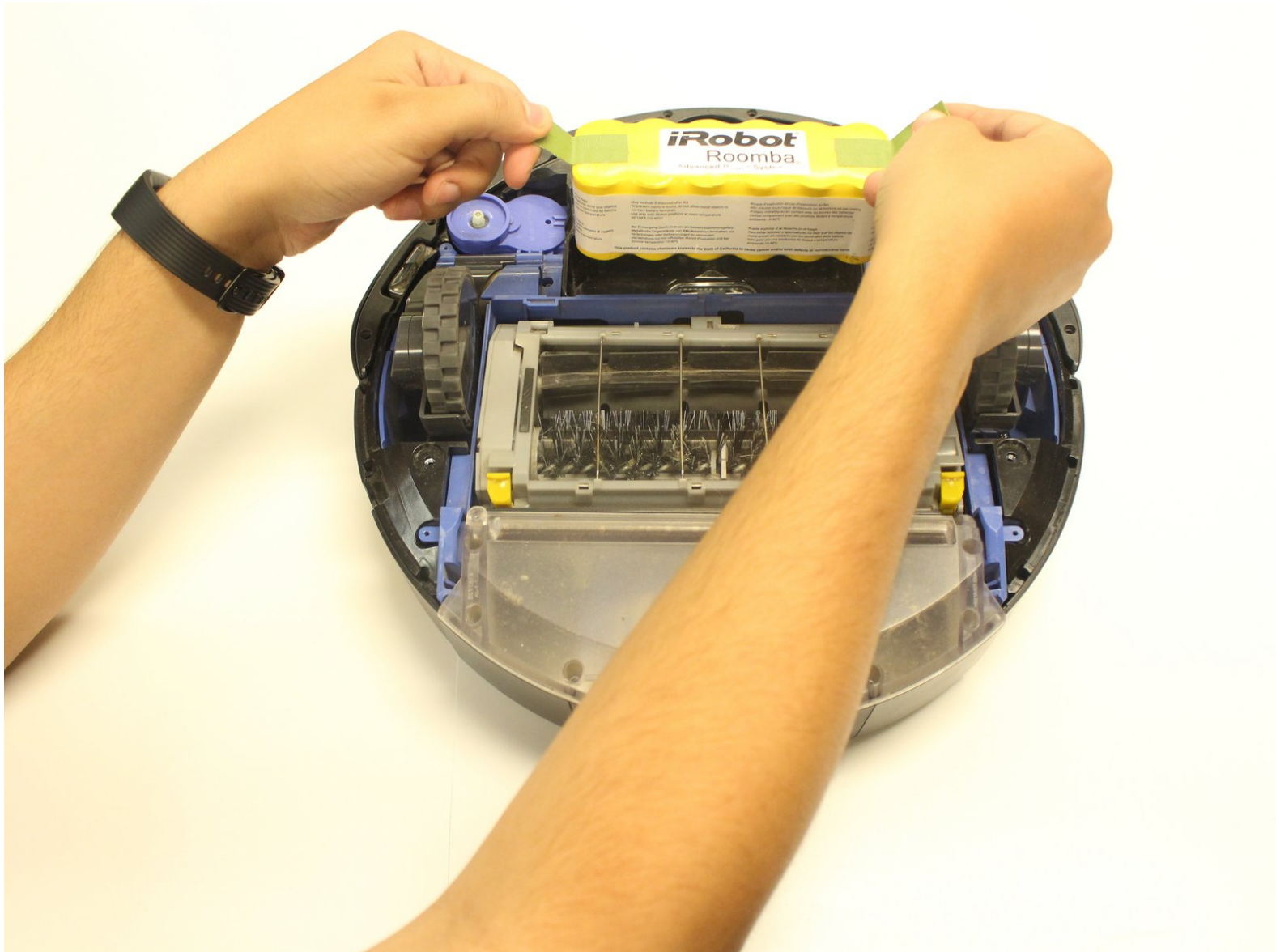




iRobot Roomba 595 Pet Series Battery Replacement

INTRODUCTION

This guide is useful for replacing a dead battery or a battery that cannot be recharged through the dock for some reason. This guide is pretty simple can be done in 3 steps, and won't break anything important

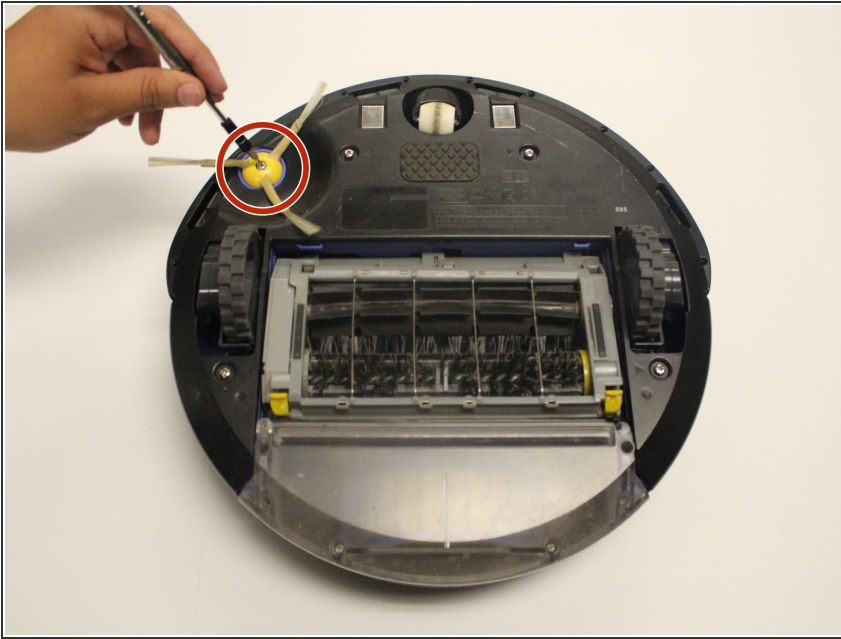

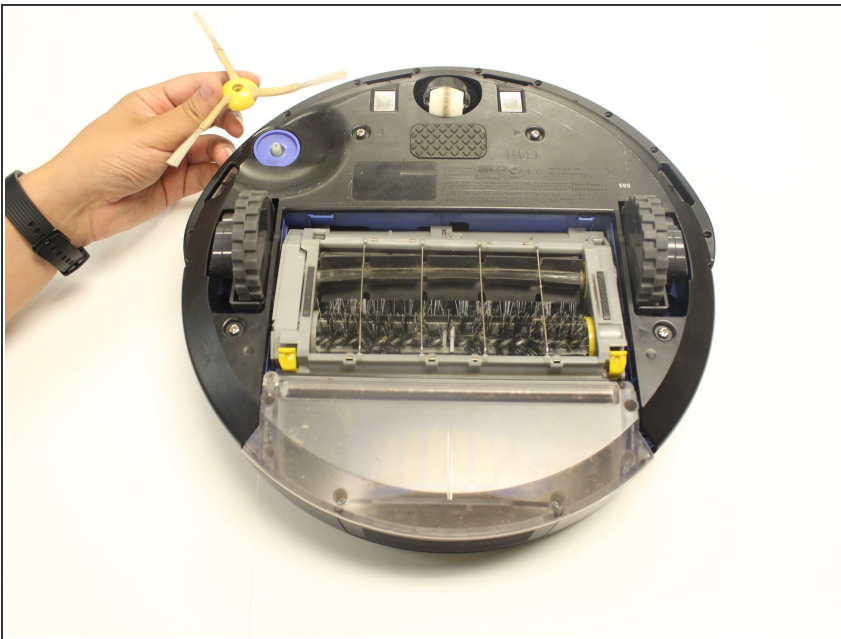
- [iRobot Roomba Replacement Battery for Select 500, 600, 700, 800, and 900 Series](#) (1)

Step 1 — Secondary Brush



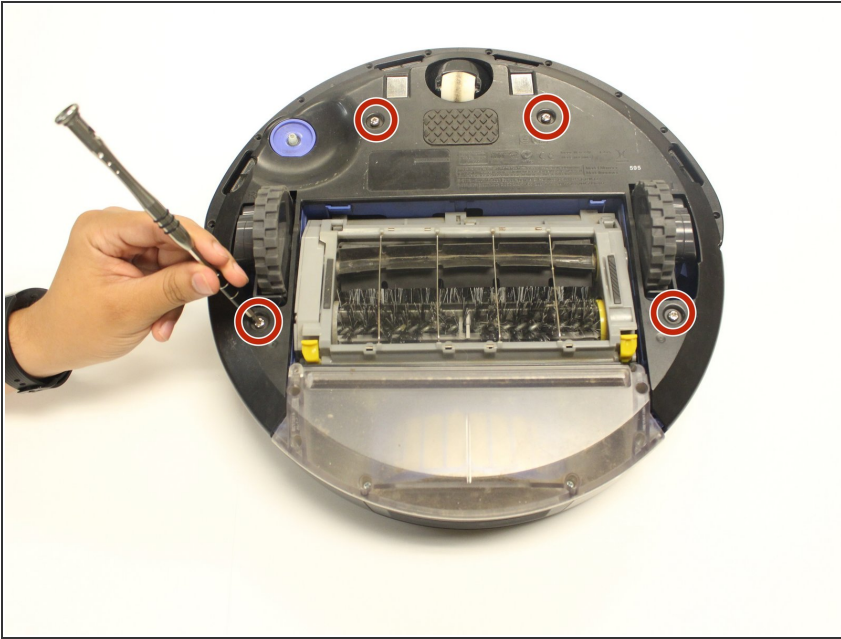
- Flip the Roomba upside down. Using the Phillips #0 screwdriver, carefully remove the 5 mm screw holding the brush in place.

Step 2



- Gently pull the brush up and remove it from the device.

Step 3 — Battery



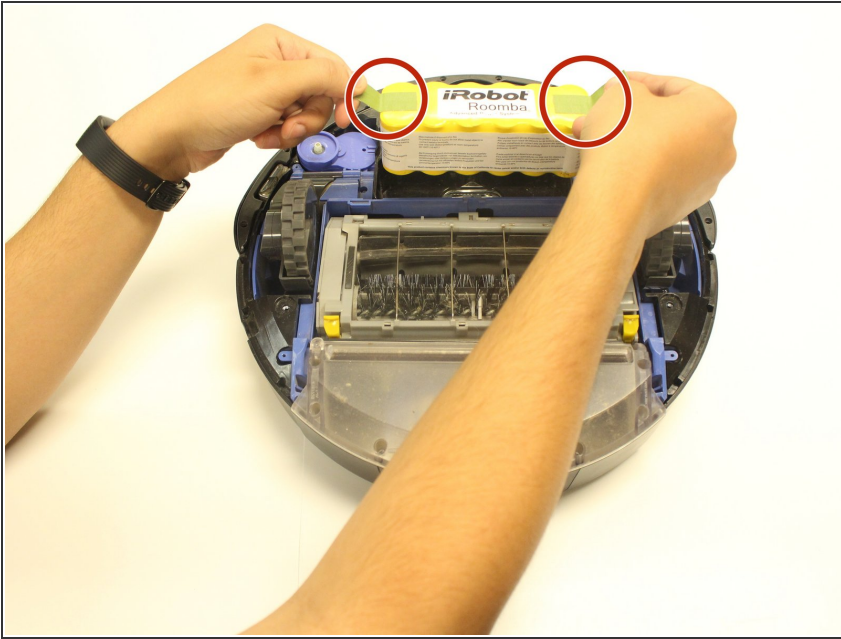
- Unscrew the four 10mm screws on the underside of the Roomba using a Phillips #1 screwdriver.

Step 4



- Remove the bottom frame of the device.

Step 5



- Grab the green tape attached to the end of the battery and remove the battery from the device.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
